Dear property owner:

The Town of Russell in cooperation with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, Northwest Region is conducting a Public Involvement Meeting regarding improvements to Little Sand Bay Road and Old County K in the Town of Russell.

The proposed improvements involve the resurfacing of Little Sand Bay Road and Old County K along with shoulder widening. The improvements are proposed on Little Sand Bay Road from Old County K to the north termini at the Little Sand Bay Campground. Improvements are also proposed on Old County K from Little Sand Bay Road to approximately 2,500 feet south of the Emil Road / Old County K intersection. Construction is currently programmed to occur during the summer of 2020 and would also include other incidental construction activities including culvert repairs, pavement marking, signing and beam guard installations.
